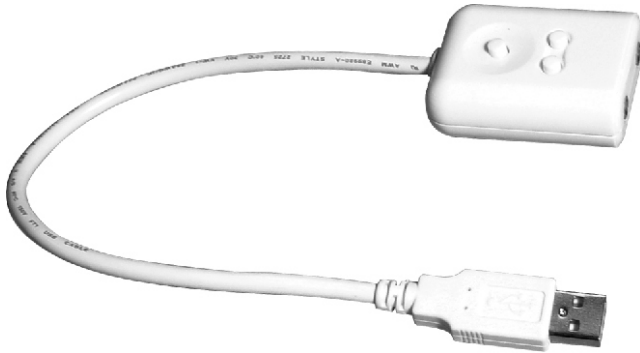


# **USB Microphone Dongle**



# Introduction

USB Microphone is a USB headworn microphone featuring a digital interface via the USB port of your computer. This light weight headset with built-in microphone provides comfort and convenience for multimedia applications, such as chat and language learning on-line. (device driver needed)
- Pc: Windows 98SE/ME/2000/XP

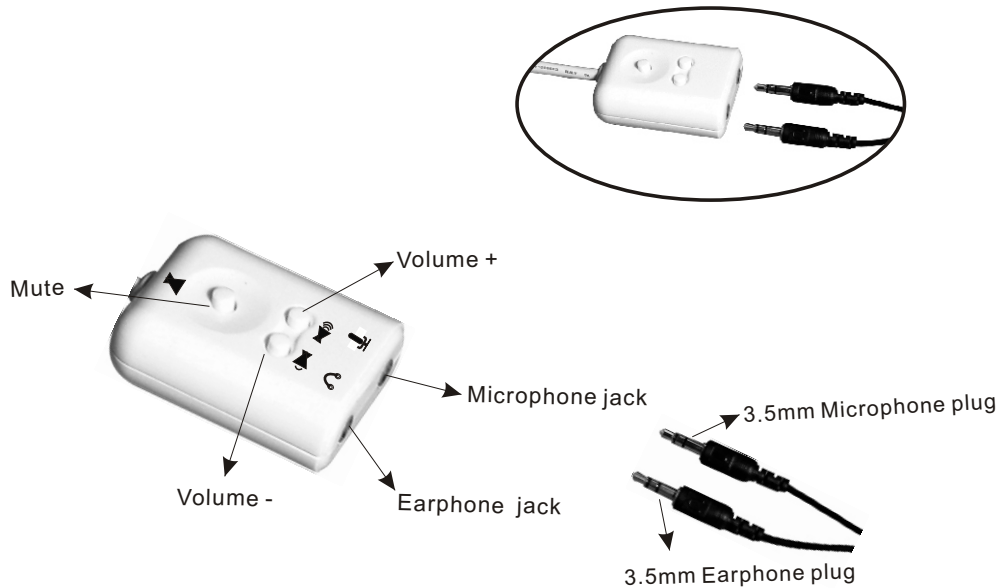

- USB specification V1.1 compliant
- USB audio and human interface device
- Volume control
- Supports 16-bit mono/stereo and 24-bit stereo for downstream( D/A converter)
- Supports 8-bit mono and 16 bit mono/stereo for upstream (A/D converter)
- 6.4 to 48KHz sample rates
- Superior signal-to-noise ratio
- Independent of sounds card
- Changeable head-worn microphone
- Bus powered device.

## Hardware Installation



1. Plug the 3.5mm stereo plugs to the microphone jack and earphone jack.
2. Plug in the USB connector of the dongle in the USB port on your PC or Mac. You are all set.

You can adjust the volume by the volume control button on the dongle.

# Software Installation for

## Macintosh OS X.x :

1. Insert the driver disk to your CD device and the icon of the disc appears on the desktop.



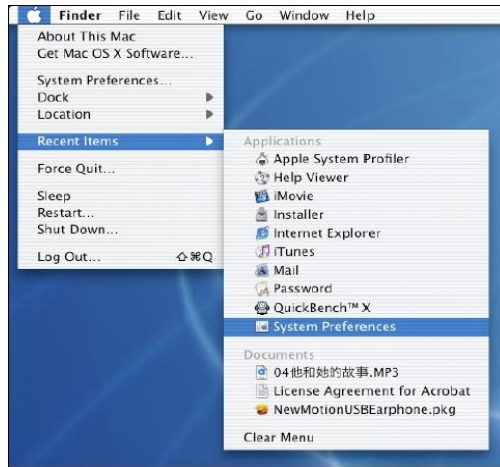
2. Double click the installer..



3. Follow the instruction to complete the installation.



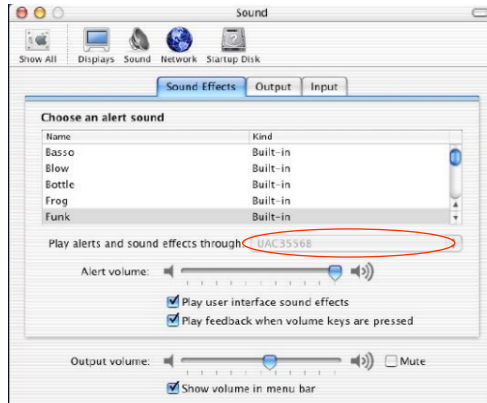
4. After restart your system, plug the USB dongle to the USB port and go to "System Preferences".



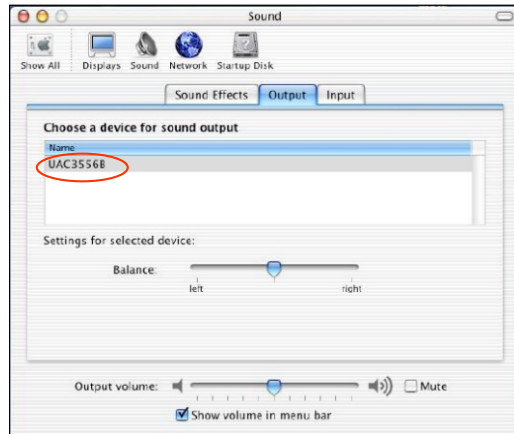
5. Double click "Sound".



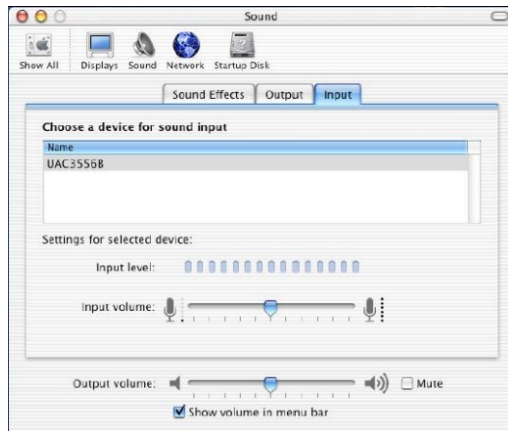
5. Play alerts and sound effects through "UAC3556B".



5. Choose "UAC3556B" for sound output.



6. Choose "UAC3556B" for sound input.



5. Close the window and you are all set.

## Software Installation for PC

### **Windows 98SE/ ME/2000/XP:**

There is no additional device driver needed.

All you have to do is plug in the USB cable to USB port on your system,.

# Software Uninstallation for

## Macintosh OS X.x :

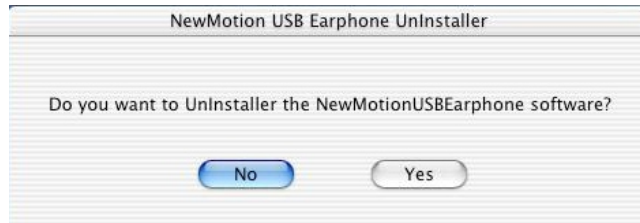
1. Insert the driver disk to your CD device and the icon of the disc appears on the desktop.



2. Double click "Uninstaller" icon



3. Follow the instruction to complete the uninstallation.
